Job Responsibilities

 - Material tracking
 - Document control
 - Progress reporting through daily logs
 - Maintaining job-site cleanliness, verification of site conditions, safety and quality control
- Take direction from Project Coordinators and Managers for day to day tasks
- Follow all safety procedures on the job site and report violations immediately to management

Physical Requirements

The physical demands described are representative of those that must be met by a Construction Management Intern to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

- Regularly required to sit and/or stand during a regular work shift of at least eight hours per day
- Required to work long periods of time outdoors, in varying weather conditions
- Occasionally required to stoop, bend, walk crouch, and climb
- Frequently required to lift and carry at least 50-90 pounds
- Required to work in conditions where dust, dirt, grease, and noise may be present



• Frequently required to walk on uneven surfaces, including natural ground and slopes in varying weather conditions
