- Attend customer pre-bid meetings and job showing, visit job sites, and keep a record
 of all verbal information disseminated by the customer during the pre-bid meeting
 and job showing
- Explain details behind each estimate, including the basis of the man-hours allocated for each task, personnel resources needed to execute each task, etc
- Maintain cost estimating tools, including databases, spreadsheets, and other computer-based applications to keep updated information on past performance and industry standards
- Assist Managers on alternative project execution approaches based on the scope of work and the most cost-effective execution methods available
- Work directly with business development to ensure we are bidding projects best suited for our company.
