- Report incidents immediately in accordance with incident reporting procedures established by the company
- Clean and prepare construction sites as needed, removing and properly disposing of debris and waste materials, digging trenches, etc.

Qualifications

- 3 years of utility experience is required
- Experience with water, sewer, and storm drain installation
- Must have strong coordination, time management, active listening, communication, critical thinking and reasoning skills
- Must have a valid driver's license with a clean driving record for a minimum of 3 years
- Ability to stand for extended periods and stoop, bend, and crouch as required

- Capability to lift and carry, frequently, at least 20 pounds and, at times, up to 50 pounds
- Ability to walk on uneven surfaces, including ground in varying weather conditions
- Ability to maintain constant awareness to multiple concurrent activities of a construction site
